**Projects:** OW2 hosts more than 100 open source infrastructure projects, including ASM, Bonita, CLIF, CompatibleOne, DocDoku, Emerginov, erOCCI, JOnAS, JORAM, Lutece, Nanoko, OpenCloudware, OpenPaas, ProActive, SpagoBI, Talend Studio, WebLab, XLcloud, XWiki. OW2 provides dissemination and community building services to large collaborative projects including OpenCloudware, OCCIware, RISCOSS, CHOReVOLUTION and AppHub.

**Initiatives:** Collaborative activities to address integration requirement in domains such as Big Data, Future Internet Software and Services and Cloud Computing, Privacy and Security.

**Local Chapters:** OW2 is building local chapters in Europe, China, Brazil and North America to help reach communities and develop relationships in regions characterized by different languages and geographies.

**Governance** OW2 operations are carried out by the **Management Office (MO)**, a permanent professional team. The team handles matters regarding general affairs, technology management and ecosystem development. The strategic decisions are made by the **Board of Directors** which represents the community. The Management Office and the Board of Directors are assisted by the **Technology Council**.
